## **NOTIFICATION**

It is to bring to the notice of the General Public that COVID Vaccination is open to everyone who is a **Citizen of India and over 18 years of age**. Anyone willing can walk into any active CVC (COVID Vaccination Centre) for either 1<sup>st</sup> Dose or 2<sup>nd</sup> Dose **without Pre-Booking/Pre-Registration in COWIN portal**. However, Pre-Registration option is also available in <u>www.cowin.gov.in</u> for beneficiaries who intend to book a slot in advance so that they may save time at the centre by foregoing any further registration. ## Any one of the following ID Cards may be carried during vaccination:

- 1. Aadhaar Card
- 2. Driving License.
- 3. Health Insurance Smart Card issued under the Scheme of Ministry of Labour.
- 4. Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA) Job Card
- 5. Official Identity Cards issued by MPs/MLAs/MLCs
- 6. PAN Card
- 7. Passbooks issued by Banks/Post Office
- 8. Passport
- 9. Pension Document
- 10. Service Identity Card issued to employees by Central/State Govt./Public limited Companies.
- 11. Vote ID
