1. **Position:** Operations Managers.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- a. This position will overlook the management and operations aspect of both the ERC and Field Operations
- b. Shall be responsible for preparing of duty roster, scheduling of resources, manpower, Ambulances, attendance, leave & performance management of EMT and Ambulance drivers
- C. Tracking and submission of MIS & Management reports.
- d. Responsible for consistent compliance and safety practices across the fleet of assigned machines during post & pre-commissioning activities including operation & maintenance.
- e. Any other roles assigned by NHM, Meghalaya.

Remuneration: Rs.1,300/- (Rupees Thirteen Hundred Only) per shift.

2. **Position:** Emergency Response Centre Physician (ERCP) / Doctor.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- a. ERCP is a position that is designed to bridge the link between ambulance care and the care of a general practitioner. EMTs require permission from the physician to administer treatments such as defibrillation and

10. **Position:** Emergency Medical Technician (EMTs).

Roles and Responsibilities:

- a. Providing Emergency Medical Care such as giving support during traumas and heart attack.
- b. To perform Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR), assessing the medical needs of the patient and providing prehospitalization emergency care such as controlling haemorrhage, treatment of shock, bandaging wounds, immobilization of painful, swollen, or deformed extremities, assist in emergency childbirth, manage general medical complaints of altered mental status, respiratory, cardiac, diabetic, allergic reaction, seizures, poisoning etc.
- C. Searching for medical identification emblems as a guide to appropriate medical care.

11. **Position:** Drivers/ Pilots.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- a. After receiving calls from the dispatcher, drives the ambulance to address or location given, using the most expeditious route, depending on traffic and whether conditions. He must observe traffic ordinances and regulations concerning emergency vehicle operation.
- b. Maintains the ambulance in efficient operating condition.
- **C.** Assist in carrying and lifting the patients in and out of the ambulance and into the receiving medical facility.
- d. Determines that the vehicle is in proper mechanical condition by checking items required by service management. Maintains familiarity with specialized equipment used by the service.
- e. Restocks and replaces used linens, blankets and other supplies.
- f. Cleans all equipment following appropriate disinfecting procedures.

- h. PILOT performance tracking:
- Response time (Start time, Base to Scene, Scene to Hospital).
