### CORRIGENDUM

### No. Health 296/2021/292

Dated. Shillong, the 03<sup>rd</sup> June 2025.

In partial modification to the Notice No. Health.296/2021/220 dated 27<sup>th</sup> May 2025, inviting "Expression of Interest (EoI) for empanelment of Private Hospitals/Diagnostic Centres for providing treatment to Government Employees under the MMA Rules 2025 (Amended) under the Government of Meghalaya, the following corrigendum is hereby issued:

- 1. "As per Notification No. Health.337/2017/Pt/47 dated 2<sup>nd</sup>May, 2025, the Classification of Diseases for the purpose of medical reimbursement under different branches of Medicine has been notified and is to be treated as Annexure-I of the EOI document."
  - All prospective applicants are requested to take note of this inclusion. The EOI document, along with **Annexure-I** (**Disease Classification List**), is available at: meghealth.gov.in and nhmmeghalaya.nic.in.
- 2. Revised 'Clause 20- Dispute Resolution' under 'Annexure 2: Memorandum of Agreement':
  - "Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this Agreement shall first be referred to the grievance redressal mechanism of the Directorate of Health Services (Medical Institutions), Government of Meghalaya. If unresolved within thirty (30) days, the dispute shall be referred to arbitration under the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, as amended.
  - The arbitration shall be conducted by a sole arbitrator mutually appointed by the Parties. Failing agreement, the arbitrator shall be appointed in accordance with the Act. The seat and venue of arbitration shall be Shillong, Meghalaya, and the language shall be English. Subject to arbitration, the Courts of Shillong shall have exclusive jurisdiction."
- 3. For any clarity regarding room categorization or entitlement of beneficiaries (e.g., General, Semi-Private, Private rooms), the applicant may refer to the Meghalaya Medical Attendance (Amendment) Rules, 2025, wherein the applicable accommodation charges and room categories have been detailed. These charges shall guide the billing and reimbursement framework under the empanelment, unless otherwise specified in the approval or authority letter issued by the competent authority.

Other terms and conditions of the original EOI remain unchanged.
